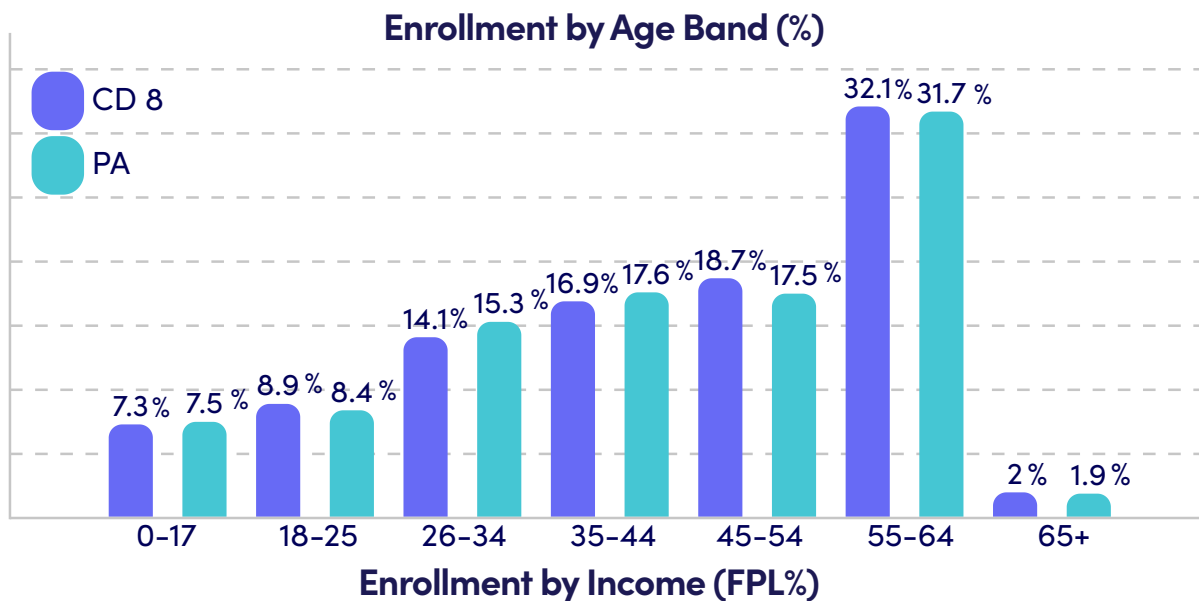

2026 Enrollment and Cost Increases for PA Congressional District 8*

- This handout shows the impact of the 2026 rate increases and the expiring enhanced premium tax credits.
- Only 73% of current enrollees are eligible for premium tax credits in 2026, compared to 90% historically, due to EPTC expiration.
- Without EPTCs, monthly premiums for Pennie enrollees have increased by 102% on average.
